## Women of the Bible - Sarai (my princess)/Sarah (Princess)

- 1. What do we see in Sarai's personality?
  - a. **Barren (Genesis 11:30)**
  - b. Beautiful even at an old age (Genesis 12:11-20; Genesis 20:2-12)
  - c. Considered God faithful who had promised her a child (Hebrews 11:11)
  - d. Wanted children very badly (Genesis 16)
  - e. <u>Tried to fulfill God's promise in her own way using her own understanding rather than faith in God</u>
    (Genesis 16 the story of Hagar and Ismael)
  - f. <u>Did not believe the Lord's words to Abraham when He told Abraham that he would have a child by Sarah; she laughed (Genesis 18:9-15)</u>
- 2. Why did God protect her when Abraham gave her to Pharaoh and Abimelech? (Genesis 12:11-20, Genesis 20:2-12)

God had plans that involved Sarah and He wanted no doubts as to whose child she was bearing; God Himself was going to open her womb for the miracle child of her old age

- 3. Against whom was Abimelech sinning if he took Sarah as his wife? (Genesis 20:6) Against God Himself
- 4. What does this possibly tell us about faithless marriages that produce children?
  - a. Those couples are sinning against God's plans for them
  - b. God may bless the child, but there will probably be problems
- 5. How did Hagar treat Sarah after the child Ismael was conceived?
  - a. <u>Hagar despised Sarah had contempt for her (Genesis 16:4)</u>
  - b. Hagar would not submit to Sarah's authority (Genesis 16:9)
- 6. What did Sarah do to Hagar and Ismael after Isaac was born? (Genesis 21:9-13 Sarah drove them away
- 7. Why did she do this?
  - a. Sarah saw Ismael mocking Isaac
  - b. <u>Sarah did not want Ismael to be an heir with Isaac (this was God's plan and she knew it Genesis</u> 21:12)
