- 1. What were love feasts? They were fellowship meals eaten in connection with the Lord's Supper
- 2. What attitudes should we have when we serve the Lord's Supper (See I Corinthians 11:20-34)?
 - a. Care for the needs of others in the church more than our own needs
 - b. We are proclaiming the Lord's Death until He returns whenever we take it and should not take it in an unworthy manner (disrespectfully)
 - c. <u>Examine ourselves to make sure we are in a right relationship with God and with</u> fellow believers
- 3. What is the danger in a "hidden reef"? They cause shipwrecks without the ship knowing it's there in time to prevent the destruction. These men were causing people's faith to be destroyed without their realizing it until it was too late.
- 4. How were these false teachers described in these verses?
 - a. **Caring only for themselves**
 - b. Had no fear of God
 - c. <u>"Clouds without rain" nothing substantial in their lives, teachings</u>
 - d. "Trees with no fruit" doubly dead, uprooted
 - e. "Wild waves of the sea casting up their own shame like foam"
 - f. "Wandering stars for whom the blackness have been reserved forever"
 - g. **Grumblers, finding fault**
 - h. Following after their own lusts
 - i. Arrogant
 - j. **Flatterers**
- 5. What are the motives of the hearts of these false teachers? Want to gain an advantage over other people
- 6. What is the fate of these teachers? <u>Judgment, conviction, darkness forever</u>
